

CAMPING GUIDELINES

Welcome to Mt Kembla Scramble Circuit. A few guidelines which will answer some of your questions and make your stay more organised:

- Please sign MNSW camp indemnity form, pay camping fees if you have not prepaid
- Display your yellow camping card on the dash of your vehicle for the duration of your stay
- You can camp and pit at your car
- NO FIRES – our camping area is directly over a high pressure gas pipeline
- There will be one central camp fire area for the evenings
- No Riding of Motorbikes in the camping/pit area
- Anyone caught riding on the Top Tracks may be excluded from the event
- Keep Entry/Exit Road Clear At All Times No Pit Sites in this area (this runs along top fence of track) In case of an emergency
- Transit Lane
 1. Motorbikes one side, pedestrians the other side
 2. competitors may ride from entry/exit of camping area down to tunnel
 3. helmet on at all times when riding up/down transit lane
 4. ride at walking pace only
 5. no parents riding up and down transit lane
 6. no doubling up and down transit lane
 7. bikes turned off when reach tunnel
 8. the tunnel echoes and fumes can build up inside so:
 9. walk bikes through tunnel turned off and up to marshalling/start line
- Garbage bags will be given out for rubbish, please place all rubbish in bins
- No noise after 10.30pm consider the racers who would like some sleep
- Male/Female Showers Provided
- No alcohol consumption in camping/pit area until after racing is finished for the day
- Washing of bikes only at designated wash bay areas
- Report any vandalism of amenities
- Report any dirty showers, blocked toilets immediately
- Keep an eye on your children during the day and evening
- No Pushbike Riding in camping area, pits, parking or spectator area
- No Riding of Motorbikes after racing has finished for the day by order of MNSW
- There will be two canteens operating over the weekend one in the top area and one in the bottom area
