

## Mt Kembla Scramble Circuit State Pit Site and Parking Guidelines

- There will be signs along the road to help all our visitors find the track
- Welcome to Wollongong Motorcycle Club Inc.
- Pit Sites
  1. Sponsors of races have been allocated pit sites in the bottom area
  2. There are two entrances and pit areas at the track - the top and the bottom
  3. There will be no set up or roping off of areas in bottom pit until Sat morning
  4. There will be parking Marshalls working to maximise pit area and make sure there is an exit lane for the day
  5. Once bottom pit is full it will be closed
  6. There is a large Pit area at top of the track also near/with campers
- Anyone caught riding on the Top Tracks may be excluded from the event by order of MNSW
- Transit Lane
  1. Motorbikes one side, pedestrians the other side
  2. No riding of motorbikes in the camping area
  3. competitors may ride from entry/exit of camping area down to tunnel
  4. ride at walking pace only
  5. helmet on at all times when riding up/down transit lane
  6. no parents riding up and down transit lane
  7. bikes turned off when reach tunnel
  8. walk bikes through tunnel turned off and up to marshalling/start line
  9. Make sure your kids know this procedure
- Spectator Parking
  1. There will be no cars without trailers in the pit areas
  2. Sydney Water have generously allowed us use of adjacent land for spectators to park – this is located just west of the track.
  3. No motorbikes at all on this Sydney Water land
- There will be two canteens over the weekend, one in the top area and one in the bottom area
- There are toilets in the tower building, a toilet block at the top area and porta loos located conveniently around the pit areas
- Please let officials know if there are any problems with the amenities
- Please place your rubbish in bins provided
- There are two wash bay areas for the weekend
- No refuelling on the start line
- Dispose of used oil in drum provided
